49.7 gb I'm trying to create a bootable USB drive for the first time, and I've followed the guides on the microsoft website. I've used the Rufus program and I have a rufus.log file in my documents. It looks like this: I've tried multiple times to boot, but I haven't been successful. The first time I got this screen: I have looked through the forums, but there don't seem to be any solutions for my problem. My OS is Windows 8.1. A: Do you have any USB connected at the moment? Like a USB keyboard or flash drive? Open Rufus. Click 'Select a disk image' and pick the ISO that you want to use. Click 'Start Download' to download the image to the disk. If you are on Windows 8/8.1 you have to make sure you can use a USB. If you can't use a USB, then you can make a LiveCD from Windows. Go to Start and type 'Create a Live USB' If you want to keep the Windows you have to use the live disk. Go to Start and type 'Disk Management' You'll probably get the message: Cannot find any Hard Disk devices on this computer. This probably means you don't have any USB or SSD attached to your computer. Rufus should have no problem

with that. Anyway, I would suggest you to follow this guide and check for the errors. Windows 8.1 has a problem with BCD boot. I suggest to try with the thumbdrive unplugged until you've to use it. Q: Why doesn't the default route (/) redirect in ASP.NET Core 2.0?
